Our 2020 Groom Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc continues in the Groom wine fashion with its fresh vibrant fruit aromas, mouth-watering palate, crisp finish and the scary too easy to drink style...oops never enough in the bottle!

The 2020 harvest was certainly one of our most challenging. Devastating bushfires that destroyed many homes in the Adelaide Hills came within a kilometer of our vineyard. We were one of the lucky ones as many grapes and grape growing properties were wiped out. Even without the fires the vintage was a shaky one from the start. We had frosts in September and October and windy weather at flowering which both reduced yields considerably.

Our 2020 is a really delicious quite light and very easy to drink style. Quite pale in color. The fruit aromas are really bright and decidedly passion fruit, lychee, grapefruit and a little pineapple. The palate is refreshing, dry and crisp. This wine is great drinking with seafood, salads, sushi and Asian cuisine or simply enjoying on its own, with friends.
